RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Parents are requested to read the contents of the school hand book carefully and in the interest of the child abide by the rules and regulations laid down by the school.
- Parents are requested to send the perforated sheet of students personal record duly filled and signed to the class teacher.
- The decision of the School authorities will be final on all matters.
- Personal hygiene, cleanliness and neatness are expected from every child.
- Disrespectful behaviour, foul language and unpleasant words should be avoided by all students as they have an adverse effect on other children.
- The Staff room and Office room should not be entered without permission or until and unless called for.
- Only vegetarian food is permitted in the campus.

UNIFORM

- Students should wear clean and well ironed uniform everyday to school; Improper dressing /incomplete uniform will mark the child as a defaulter.
- Shoes, belt, socks, ID card tags have to be washed regularly.
- Students have to wear the standardized uniform of the school.
- Girls have to wear appropriate inner wear (slips and bloomers) at all times.
- Boys are not allowed to wear coloured tee shirts beneath their school shirts
- Children accompanying parents during PTM days must also come in school uniform.
- Students are not permitted to wear any fancy or gold jewellery, wear colourful clips, use nail polish or mehendi, wear make up during school hours
- Girls with shoulder length hair, must tie it into two pony tails and those with longer hair must tie it into plaits. White hair band and ribbon must be used to keep the hair neat.
- Fancy watches with big and colourful dials must not be used.
- Proper hair cut for boys is recommended. Fancy hair cut, streaking/highlighting the hair with fashion colours is not permitted.

BIRTHDAYS

- Students are permitted to wear colour clothes and distribute chocolates in class.
- Parents are requested not to send sweets, cakes or any other eatables to celebrate their ward's birthday.
- No birthday parties are held in the school.

ATTENDANCE

- Be in school by 8.30 am. All pupils arriving after 8.40 am will be deemed to be late.
- Parents are kindly requested to inform the school if their children are unable to come to the school. Parents can telephone the Office to inform the school of their children's absence, or use the email facility to inform the same.
- Produce either a medical certificate or a letter from parents or guardians to their respective class teachers, if absent for more than two days from school /unable to participate in Games/CCA. However for school examinations, medical certificate must be produced.
- Students suffering from contagious disease such as chicken pox, mumps, sore eyes, skin disorder, fever, cold and cough will not be allowed to sit in the class or to appear for exams. Such a student will produce a fitness certificate on returning.

• Attendance on the re-opening and closing days and after special holidays is compulsory. Under unavoidable circumstances, owing to illness, if a student cannot attend, his/her absence shall be validated with a medical certificate from a registered practitioner

Taking care of personal belongings

- 1. Take personal responsibility for your belongings: books, stationaries, lunch bag, water bottles, umbrellas, keys, etc. Do not leave them lying unattended.
- 2. Please note that any item in the Lost and Found section will be retained by the school only for a maximum period of one month. If unclaimed the item will pass on to charity.
- 3. Do not bring to school any equipment not required for your lessons or CCAs.
- 4. Any electronic gadgets, such as **MP3 players**, **I Pods**, **cell phones and game consoles** will be **confiscated** upon detection if brought without authorization or a valid reason.

RESPONSIBILITIES TOWARDS SCHOOL - GENERAL

Discipline is the law of nature; without it, nothing works. Inculcating discipline amongst children is the most significant aspect of education and is not confined to school alone. Parents too, must co-operate with the school in observing these norms:

- 1. To protect and promote the sanctity of the school by maintaining peace, order and harmony in school.
- 2. Maintain cleanliness in the campus.
- 3. Safeguard and preserve school property.
- 4. Respect elders, teachers and friends.
- 5. Participate in all school activities, sportingly.
- 6. Any kind of fiction and non-fiction books that have adult content must not be brought to school, shared or discussed with peers.
- 7. Regularity in submission of class work/home work.
- 8. Maintain discipline in corridor at all times. Students will not leave the class after every period or loiter in the corridor.
- 9. Students will line up and walk only on the left whether going up the stairway or coming down.
- 10. Maintain silence in the library.
- 11. Take good care of the books.
- 12. No money collection for any purpose is allowed to be made in the school without prior permission of the Principal.
- 13. Non-vegetarian food and junk food is strictly discouraged.
- 14. Inorder to foster a keen sense of collective responsibility and a sense of belongingness, house system is followed. Every student is assigned a house Red/Blue/Green/Yellow during his/her admission and continues to be in the same throughout their schooling.
- 15. Shakthi Buzz, sent through e-mail gives a glimpse of all the activities/events conducted for the month.

- 16. Every child by rotation becomes the 'Star of the week' of their respective class. The child remains in the limelight with extra responsibilities endorsed.
- 17. Bus monitors and lady conductors are responsible for orderly behavior in the bus.
- 18. In order to acquire competency in spoken English, all students must converse in English while they are in school and in the bus.
- 19. Using unfair means in a test or examination is a grave offence. A student who is found using unfair means will be awarded zero in the subject and will be issued a strict warning. Repetition of the same offence will result in his / her expulsion from the school.

TRANSPORTATION

- Transportation provides a bus service that runs on various routes throughout the city for all students. Students are picked up approximately between 7:20 am 8.30 am and taken to drop-off points at the end of the school day.
- When making bus routes, there are two competing interests: having passengers walk short distances from/to their homes versus having short commuting times for all passengers on the bus. Pick-up/drop-off points are selected by balancing these competing interests.
- GPRS tracking of school bus is facilitated to the parents.
- Students availing transport facility should be 5 minutes early at the pick-up points to avoid unnecessary delay in reaching the school. If students are not reporting to school on a given day, prior information must be given to the respective/bus conductors.
- Parents who make independent transport arrangements for their ward will be fully responsible for the same. They must ensure that proper verification of drivers is done and all safety measures are taken to avoid any untoward incident.
- Any request for change in routes and bus stops will not be entertained during the course of the session.
- It will be the sole responsibility of the parents/ guardians to escort the pupil to and from the fixed bus-stops.

SECURITY SYSTEM

- School has installed CCTV cameras to cover all areas for a secure school environment.
- Entry to school is through main gate which is manned 24 x 7 by competent security guards.
- Parents to show their ID Card at the time of entry and leaving with their ward at the end of the school/special occasions.
- Visitors are allowed entry only through issue of Visitor Pass.
- Parents/Visitors are not allowed to meet any student during working hours without prior permission.
